

An Agreement between SOUTH CAROLINA TECHNICAL COLLEGE SYSTEM and SOUTH CAROLINA FIRE ACADEMY



The South Carolina Fire Academy (SCFA) and the South Carolina Technical College System (SCTCS) recognize the need to promote and facilitate higher education among Fire Academy training completers. In an effort to ease this process and promote the closer coordination of courses, the SCTCS and SCFA hereby enter into the following agreement effectively replacing the "Guidelines for Exemption Credit for Certification Training by the National Fire Academy or the SCFA" executed in January 2003.

TARGET AUDIENCE

The agreement provides guidelines for awarding exemption credit for courses taken at the SCFA and includes a course equivalencies list.

- SCFA students who have completed training courses and seek enrollment at one of the 16 technical colleges
- Students seeking enrollment in programs such as, but not limited to, the following may realize a
 greater benefit in the application of this agreement toward program completion:

 Associate in Applied Science: major in Fire Science Technology or General
 Technology
 Certificate: Fire Science, Fire Service Technology, Fire Service Technology Advanced, or Emergency Management and Protection
- Application of this agreement is dependent upon specific program offerings and requirements at each college.

GUIDELINES

- 1. Technical colleges shall award exemption credit for national Fire Academy training based on recommendations made by the American Council on Education (ACE) whenever such recommendations are available. If ACE recommendations are not available, technical colleges shall award exemption credit based on the criteria listed in #2 below.
- 2. Technical colleges shall award exemption credit for SCFA training on the following basis:

Every fifteen (15) contact hours of training plus a required final exam shall equate to one-half (.5) academic credit hour for purposes of granting exemption credit. The final exam may be a written exam and/or practical evaluation and must require a passing test score. A student must complete the training with an overall average of 70 percent or higher, including satisfactory completion of all required physical and practical exercises. Training sponsored and conducted by the SCFA may be completed at the SCFA facility in Columbia or at any other SCFA designated site.

- 3. The total allowable exemption credit is determined by the college with adherence to applicable SCTCS policy and procedures.
- 4. Students may receive a maximum of 9.0 credit hours for SCFA 1000 series courses completed. All other SCFA coursework submitted for exemption credit must be at the 2000 series level or above.

- 5. Students receiving 9.0 credit hours for 1151 Firefighter Candidate School will not receive additional credit for 1152 OSHA Firefighter, 1153 NFPA Firefighter 1, 1154 NFPA Firefighter II, and 2722 Hazardous Materials as content from those courses are included in 1151.
- 6. Technical colleges will grant exemption credit for National Certification courses by recognizing third party credentialing by International Fire Service Accreditation Congress (IFSAC) and/or the National Board on Fire Service Professional Qualifications (ProBoard). IFSAC and Proboard issued certificates with official seals and seal numbers will be accepted in place of transcripts for these courses.

REVIEW OF THE AGREEMENT

- 1. The SCTCS and SCFA will designate officials who will be responsible for all aspects of the agreement at both entities. Representing the SCFA will be Bonita Watters, Instructional Design Supervisor. Representing the SCTCS will be the Executive Vice President at the SCTCS System Office, or his/her designee at either entity.
- 2. Both parties are to communicate the conditions of this agreement to their respective clientele (external and internal constituents). The SCFA and SCTCS will review this agreement annually to make adjustments or amendments as deemed appropriate to maintain the integrity of the educational programs and articulation of courses.
- 3. The agreement will remain in effect until terminated by either party upon written notice. Such notice should be given at least one year in advance of the effective date of termination, and students who have signed an intent to participate document prior to termination may take advantage of its terms for two years after termination becomes effective.
