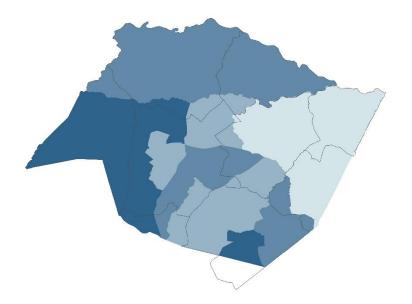


## **SALUDA**County Profile Risks and Rankings

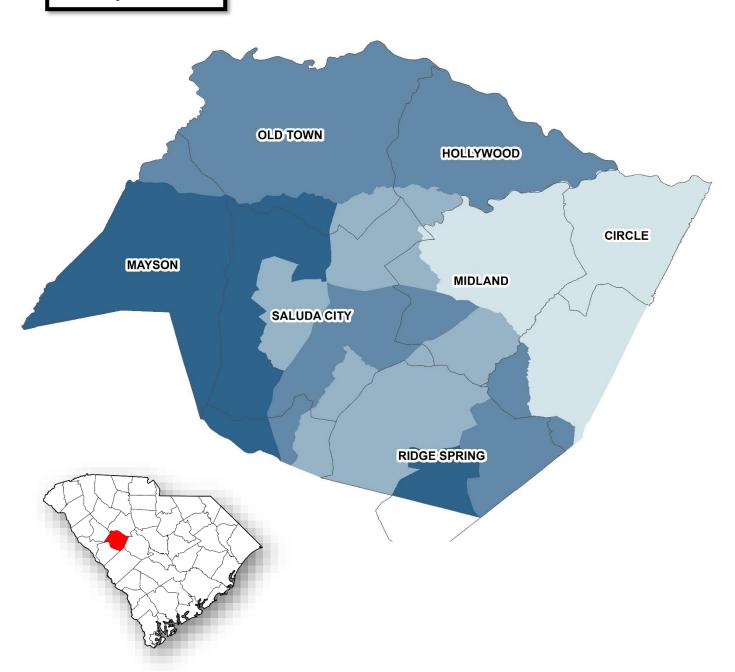
