S.C. Fire Academy Offers Virtual Fire & Life Safety Educator-I (4165) Course

This free virtual course is designed for individuals who coordinate and deliver comprehensive community fire and injury prevention programs. Topics include: fire prevention history, learning styles, methods for effective teaching, public relations, high-risk populations, professionalism, developing life safety curricula, and evaluation & assessment. There are no prerequisites.

The five-day class will be held live on a virtual platform Monday-Thursday. For convenience, the written exam will be held at the Academy Regional Office closest to each student's fire department (in person) on Friday. Please note, a face mask must be worn.

Students who successfully complete the course will receive an accredited certificate from IFSAC and an application for a ProBoard accredited certificate for NFPA 1035: Fire and Life Safety Educator.

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I register for this class? Registration for all Academy classes is the same, through your Fire Portal account, with the approval of your Fire Chief or Training Officer.

What type of virtual learning platform is used by the Academy? For this class, the Academy utilizes Zoom, a real-time video conferencing tool, that allows users to add files, share applications, and use a virtual whiteboard to interact with others. This tool is easy to use and opens in a browser (no software to install).

What are the system requirements for virtual classes? Students must use a desk-top or laptop with a webcam, microphone, and a common web browser (Chrome or Firefox). Phoning in to class is not permitted.
