For South Carolina fire service personnel, the SC Fire Academy is offering its newly released Fire and Emergency Services Administration course. This 40-hour chief officer course is designed as an alternative to the Fire Officer I accredited-level program, for agencies that do not require accredited certification. This course will prepare students for leadership success beyond the fire ground by becoming a successful administrator, with a focus on leadership from an administrative point of view.

There are no prerequisites. However, there is an end-of-course exam. Successful students will receive a SC Fire Academy course certificate.
