

State Fire Marshal Policy

Service and Maintenance Manuals for Pre-Engineered Suppression Systems and Portable Fire Extinguisher Manufacturers

May 9, 2011 Policy No. 11-001

SCOPE:

This policy will provide information regarding requirements by the Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM) for manufacturer's installation, service and maintenance manuals for pre-engineered fire suppression systems and portable fire extinguishers.

PURPOSE:

To provide specific information on which installation service and maintenance manuals are accepted by OSFM, and the acceptable format.

BACKGROUND:

Previous memorandums from OSFM required only original manufacturer's installation, service and maintenance manuals or hard copy service manuals in order to install, service, maintain or repair preengineered systems or portable fire extinguishers. This policy replaces all previous memorandums.

WHAT IS REQUIRED?

Each permitted employee of a licensed fire equipment company must have the manufacturer's installation service and maintenance manuals for each **pre-engineered system** and/ or each type of **portable fire extinguisher** that he wishes to be licensed to install or service. The manuals should be immediately accessible.

Manual Types:

Manufacturer's installation, service and maintenance manuals may be provided in any medium including, but not limited to:

- Original manuals
- Photo copies
- o CD's
- o Electronic media
