

Documenting Injury Severity

Pain only; superficial cuts and burns; sprains and twists

2nd degree localized burns; conscious with other injuries; smoke inhalation only

Broken arm or leg bones; requires pain medicine; widespread 2nd degree burns

3rd degree burns; massive bleeding or trauma; airway burns; shock; often transported to a burn center
