How to Code a False Alarm in NFIRS

Malicious Alarms (710-715)

These alarms were activated intentionally by someone attempting to cause malice or fear.

System Malfunction (730-736)

These alarms were activated because there is an issue with the system.

The alarm is malfunctioning and there is no emergency.

Unintentional Operation (740-746)

These alarms were activated because there was a perceived hostile environment, such as smoke or high-heat. There is no actual emergency.

Additionally, the alarms may have been accidentally tripped, or they were being tested.
