


Actions Taken in NFIRS


Every incident report must include **at least one** action taken, which is listed in the Basic Module.



These actions taken should reflect what the entire department did at the scene.



These actions should be listed in order of significance- *not necessarily* in chronological order.



Q: Why do we not always use "Incident Command" as our Primary Action Taken?

A: Incident command is always presumed to be taking place. By varying what actions are taken at the scene, we can obtain more useful data for future analysis.

Incident command should be used as the primary action when the department does nothing else of significance.
