EMS & Transport Actions

If you are providing medical care during an incident, it's important to record your actions correctly in an NFIRS report.

Always record the level of care you provide on scene, not your abilities to provide more advanced care.



Provide first aid

Check for injuries

Medical evaluation of patient

Provide BLS

Basic life support

CPR and use of an AED

EMT level actions

Provide ALS

Advanced life support

Invasive skills

Advanced airway management

Starts intravenous lines

Paramedic level actions

General notes about actions taken:

- Record only those actions taken by your fire department.
- Enter your actions taken by order of importance not order of when they occurred.
- Use up to three actions taken for your fire department per incident report. More actions are available by using the apparatus and personnel modules.
