For the **2024 renewal cycle**, current permit holders must be ICC/NAFED certified for the class of the permit currently held.

**A**: It depends on the classification(s) held. If you hold one (or both) of the following, you must register and pass the exam(s).

- ICC/NAFED Certified Portable Fire Extinguisher Technician
- ICC/NAFED Pre-Engineered Kitchen Fire Extinguishing Systems Technician Afterwards, you will upload the appropriate certificate.

A: Certifications and renewals must be completed by Friday, May 31, 2024.
