Fire Officer III is a nine-day Executive Officer class.

The selection of students goes beyond the current SCFA registration and qualification procedures and includes a selection process.

Course Fee: \$97* (includes daily lunch)

Students must also complete an application (see below) for this course. This provides their current rank and a detailed description of their daily duties. Because rank alone does not provide an accurate picture of daily duties, staff will use a combination of information to determine each student's eligibility for the course.



Letter of Recommendation

Obtain a letter of recommendation from your Department Head/Chief Fire Officer outlining how this class will benefit you and your department. This letter must be on official department letterhead. Applications will not be processed without this letter.

Minimum Prerequisite: Fire Officer II

Experience will also be evaluated in order to qualify. This is critical for the overall success of the class. Students work in groups to complete activities and present their final project on county-wide consolidation that addresses all JPRs for FOIII. Budgeting, human resources, and training are among the topics covered. If a student lacks experience in these areas, that student will be a liability to their group. Students' grades will be impacted if members of a group lack experience.

Course Summary

This nine-day course is designed to take the student to NFPA 1021 Fire Officer III level. Students will complete activities and develop a final in-class presentation.

Subjects include: Personnel staffing, hiring, promotions, professional development, member benefits, employee accommodations, development of training programs, community risk reduction, preparation of budgets, budget management, purchasing processes, information management systems, data analysis, organizational improvement, evaluation of inspection programs, development of a safety plan, incident mitigation planning, conducting a post-incident analysis, planning for special resources, accident and injury prevention, and fire service integration in emergency management.

There are no tests, but there is a significant amount of reading, research, activity completion, and planning outside of class. Each student's success is determined by satisfactory completion of 16 activities and associated presentations, including extensive group work.

Students who pass the course will receive an accredited certificate from IFSAC and an application for a ProBoard accredited certificate for NFPA 1021 Fire Officer III.

Dorm room and breakfast are not included in course fee
