

Offering in 2024: Basic Fire Investigations Course











For South Carolina fire service and law enforcement personnel, SC State Fire partners with local fire investigators, insurance industry investigators, SLED, ATF, and SC IAAI to offer the Basic Fire Investigations program. **UPDATE:** There is available space in the September 2024 class.

This intense six-day, 48-hour course is designed to cover the basic principles and practices of fire investigation through NFPA 1033-Standard for Professional Qualifications for Fire Investigator and NFPA 921-Guide for Fire and Explosion Investigations.

Topics include: Fire scene investigation methodology, scene safety, basic fire science, fire patterns, building systems, electrical systems, appliances, fuel systems, human behavior, origin determination. cause determination, classification of cause, legal considerations, evidence, and documentation.

Successful students will receive an IFSAC-Fire Investigator I certificate and be eligible to apply for ProBoard certification. This course meets the pre-requisite to apply for IAAI Fire Investigation Technician certification.

Class Time: 8 a.m. - 5 p.m.

Prepare for some sessions to go beyond 5 p.m., and homework assignments in the evenings.
