



Roadmap to Retirement: Taking Control of Your Finances and Future

The South Carolina Fire Academy is offering an in-person financial success strategy workshop for:

- Firefighters wanting to take control of their financial future,
- Fire department recruit school coordinators or members of the Command staff, or
- Anyone in the fire service interested in learning more about financial planning.

According to studies, many young and older adults do not have a clear focus or set measurable goals. They have not been taught the personal financial skills required to avoid making decisions that will lead to financial failure. Our goal is to correct this! This course teaches firefighters how to change the behavioral issues and mindset that lead to overwhelming debt, crippling their ability to be financially independent, and how to wipe out debt and regain control of their most valuable asset: themselves and their ability to generate income. We will cover a variety of investment strategies that can help anyone become financially independent - once we have learned how to free up and increase our income.

The ultimate goal is for firefighters to take control of their personal, professional, and financial futures. When they retire, they can enjoy life after the fire service with a fully funded retirement plan based on the strategy and tactics set up and implemented while still on the job.

This four-hour program teaches fire service personnel several important topics. These include how to establish a "Why," set goals, establish a working budget, run cost analysis on major purchases, live debt-free, manage financial accounts, better understand the "One Percent" fund, calculate the value of a pension (PORS/SCRS), invest for the future, and how to tie it all together to form a personal "Roadmap to Retirement."
