BLACKHAWK HELICOPTER PROP OFFERS UNIQUE TRAINING OPPORTUNITY

The South Carolina Fire Academy recently acquired a new UH-60 Blackhawk Helicopter prop to provide realistic hands-on training that allows firefighters to experience the challenging physical and psychological effects.

"This heavy-duty fire-training prop allows for a unique training experience," ARFF Program Coordinator Captain Joe Charleston said. "It also has movable rotors, a cockpit, and cabin doors."

Every critical environmental condition a first responder may face during an emergency can be simulated. These conditions include darkness, integrated smoke and sound effects, intense This prop was acquired in conjunction with Lion Training Systems.

flames, fuel spills, and real heat – depending on the desired helicopter, cockpit, or cabin fire scenario.

"The prop is ideal when practicing positioning of apparatus, angle of attack, and stretching the proper hose lines while the helicopter remains fully involved," Charleston said.



The UH-60 Blackhawk Helicopter prop also includes an integrated cooling system. This allows for long-duration fire simulations while minimizing steel fatigue and wear.

The upgraded features on the prop also provide another tool for refresher burns.

"Not only will we incorporate this prop into our 3402 Municipal Approach to ARFF class, but we hope to offer the Response to Rotorcraft Accidents course real soon," he said.

ACADEMY ACCOMMODATIONS

SCFA Dormitory

Students staying overnight enjoy the recently renovated dormitory with hotel-like accommodations and an expanded weight room/gym area. Dormitory rooms are first-come, first-served. Each room has a private bathroom, and linens are provided.

Single and double occupancy is available. Single occupancy is \$50/night; double occupancy is \$25/night. Please make your room selection during the registration process.

In the event the State Fire Academy's dormitory is full or unavailable, the DoubleTree by Hilton is less than 10 miles away (15 minutes) from the Academy site.
