

# VIRTUAL LEADERSHIP TRAINING SERIES

The South Carolina Fire Academy presents a *virtual* workshop centered around fire service leadership training. This live instructor-led workshop will be delivered through a virtual platform.

## Aggressive Fireground Tactics

There is a great need for aggressive tactics, quick decision-making, and proactive firemanship on today's fireground. With rapidly evolving fire behavior, the mission to quickly save lives is more important now than ever. The prelude to this class looked at how leadership will impact aggressive fireground tactics. This class focuses on what tactics are needed to give the external customers of the fire service a fighting chance. The presentation will cover tactics for the first arriving company, engine tactics, support company tactics, and aggressive command presence on the fire scene. The citizens who believe in the oath we take also believe that the fire service will show up in their time of need and go to work. Fireground tactics begin with a mindset, are developed through training, and must be executed with aggression.
