Perspective Driven Leadership for the Fire Service

What exactly is “Perspective Driven Leadership?” During this two-hour course, I will discuss my on-duty life-threatening medical emergency survivor story. Throughout my recovery, I used the time as an opportunity to reflect about life and leadership, especially how they interact at the station and at home. This shifted my outlook resulting in the single greatest gift I did not know I needed - perspective.

During our time together, I will share with you lessons learned from different mentors. Based on those discussions, I created 12 simple steps that helped me change everything I “thought” I was doing right. These steps not only benefitted my life as a leader on the job, but also at home.
