



EMD GRANT-FUNDED OFFERING: PIPELINE AWARENESS

The South Carolina Fire Academy is offering a *free* grant-funded Pipeline Awareness course. This EMD grant-funded 4-hour course will provide responders with key information on the role of pipelines in their communities, how to recognize pipeline right-of-ways, and how to interpret pipeline markers. The course will also highlight the functions of the Pipeline Control Center during emergencies and outline awareness-level responder actions from the initial call through on-scene safety control. Local utility representatives will also be in attendance to offer additional insight.
