Special Offering: L956 All Hazards Liaison Officer Course

The Palmetto Incident Support Team (IST) is offering the L956-All Hazards Liaison Officer course in March 2026. This course provides local and state-level emergency responders with a robust understanding of the duties, responsibilities, and capabilities of an effective Liaison Officer on an All-Hazards Incident Management Team.

This course is an instructor-led training that supports learning through discussion, lecture, and active participation in multiple exercises that provides a realistic, scenario-driven approach to mastering the skills required of a Liaison Officer. Exercises, simulations, discussions, and a final exam enable attendees to process and apply their new knowledge.

Prerequisites: Must be documented on SC Fire Academy transcript at the time of registration.
