Special Offering: Incident Management Team Position-Specific Training

The Palmetto Incident Support Team is offering a special six-day training program that combines two All-Hazards Incident Management Team position-specific courses: L0965 Resource Unit Leader (RESL) and L0964 Situation Unit Leader (SITL). This is not a choice between two courses. The program is designed as a single, integrated learning experience, and students are required to complete both courses during the six-day session. Registration is for the entire program; enrollment in only one course is not permitted.

- **L0965 RESOURCE UNIT LEADER:** This course provides an overview of RESL responsibilities, the planning section, and the planning process to contextualize the resources unit. It explores specific RESL functions and responsibilities, including resource tracking systems, operational planning, and resource products/outputs. Exercises, simulations, discussions, and a final exam enable students to process and apply their new knowledge.
- **L0964 SITUATION UNIT LEADER:** This course helps participants establish the essential core competencies required for performing the duties of the SITL in an all-hazards incident. These responsibilities include processing information and intelligence and developing displays. The course is an instructor-led training that supports learning through discussion, lecture, and active participation in multiple exercises.
